Get There: I-75 to Corkscrew Rd Exit 123, then east on CR850 Corkscrew Rd

17.4 miles.

Admission: Free.

When: Open daily. One hour before sunrise to one hour after sunset.


What: 5.5 miles of marked loop hiking trails through pine flatwoods and along the edge of a 5,000 sawgrass marsh.

Birds, deer, alligators.

Most of the trails are wide and flat. An observation deck and tower offer wide views of the Corkscrew Marsh.



















Controlled Burns Maintain Forest Health.
