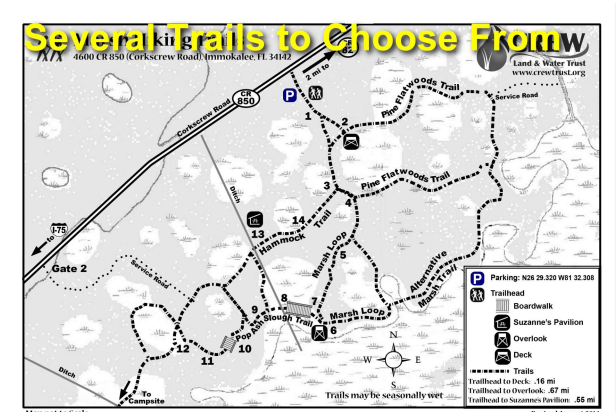
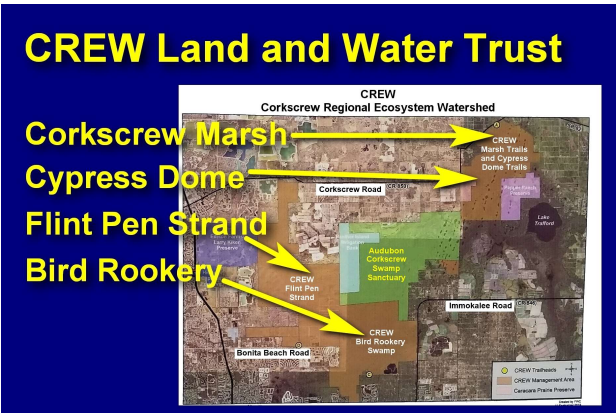


**CREW Marsh Trail**  
 (CREW = Corkscrew Regional Ecosystem Watershed)  
**Website:** <https://crewtrust.org/crew-marsh-trails/>  
**Where:** 4600 Corkscrew Rd, Immokalee, FL 34142  
**Get There:** I-75 to Corkscrew Rd Exit 123, then east on CR850 Corkscrew Rd 17.4 miles.

**Admission:** Free.  
**When:** Open daily. One hour before sunrise to one hour after sunset.  
**What:** 5.5 miles of marked loop hiking trails through pine flatwoods and along the edge of a 5,000 sawgrass marsh. Birds, deer, alligators.  
 Most of the trails are wide and flat.  
 An observation deck and tower offer wide views of the Corkscrew Marsh.





**Controlled Burns Maintain Forest Health.**

- Thin out undergrowth and flammable dead leaves and limbs to prevent a destructive wildfire.
- Reduce insect population.
- Destroy invasive plants.
- Return nutrients to the soil – much faster than decomposition.
- Let in sunlight for natural growth.
