Island. One of the Ten Thousand Islands.

Connected by causeway since 1956. Only 150 acres: 0.22 sq mi.

But has up to 20 foot height: Calusa shells discarded 500 BC-2000 AD.


Height offered protection from floods.

Settled early (1880s): Because of height.

Population today: 346.
