When: Daily 7am to sunset.

**Education Center 9am to 10pm Mon-Sat.** 

Admission: Free.

## What: 50 acre wetlands.

- 3,500-foot boardwalk over the eastern side of the park.
- Plus trails and six lookout pavilions around the lakes in the western side of the park.
- 2,500 square foot Education Center.
- Freedom Memorial tribute to the lives lost on 9/11/01 in the terrorist attacks and to the heroes of past and present wars.

## Wildlife I have seen there include:

- Birds: Anhingas, egrets, various kinds of herons, gallinules, woodpeckers, limpkins.
- Reptiles: Alligators, turtles, frogs, iguanas, snakes.
- Others: Blue crabs, marsh rabbits, raccoons.

- Armadillos, otters.


















































Florida Blue Crabs
