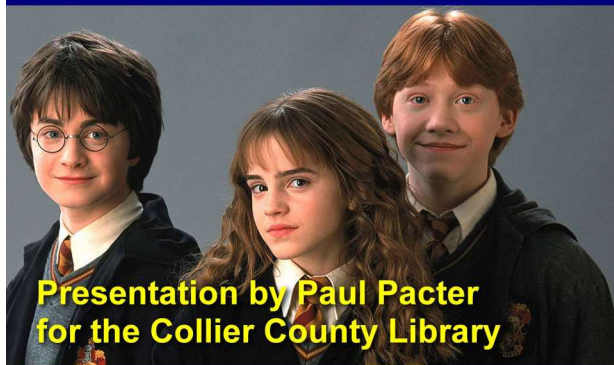

Leavesden Film Studios Where all Harry Potter films were made.

- Until 1994 Leavesden was an aircraft factory making military airplanes.
- 1994 became Leavesden film studios.
- 2000 filming of Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone began. Great Hall was the first set built.
- Filming took place 2000-2009.

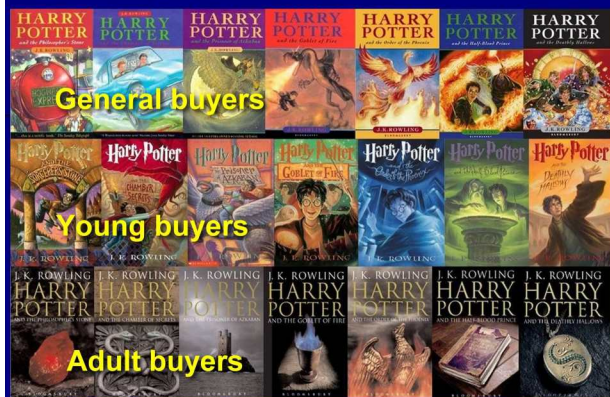

Some more J. K. Rowling Trivia

- Applied to Oxford University. Rejected.
- Was researcher for Amnesty Intl. when she got the idea for Harry Potter while on a delayed train to London in 1990.
- Based the character of Hermione Granger on herself when she was 11.
- 1993 separated from her first husband, no job, baby daughter. Went on welfare.
- 1997 Philosopher's Stone published.
- Initial print run of 1,000 copies. Today, those copies sell for \$20-30,000.

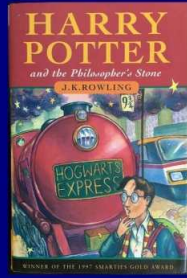
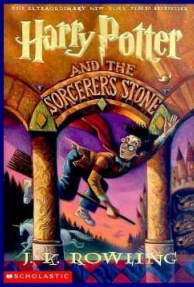

- Over the ten years, an incredible 588 sets were created for Harry Potter at Leavesden Studios.
 - Preserved as a tourist attraction today.
 - Meanwhile, many other movies are being filmed there.

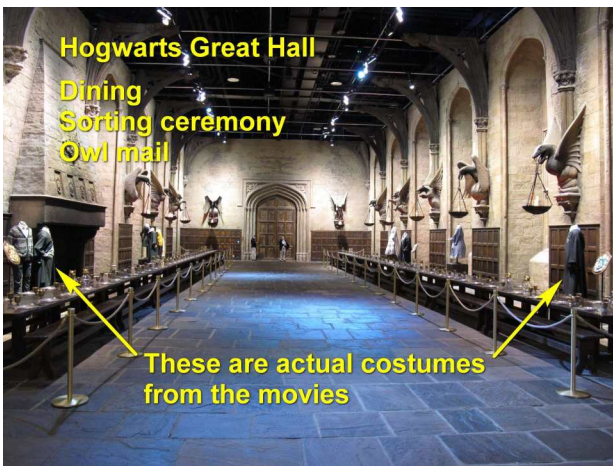

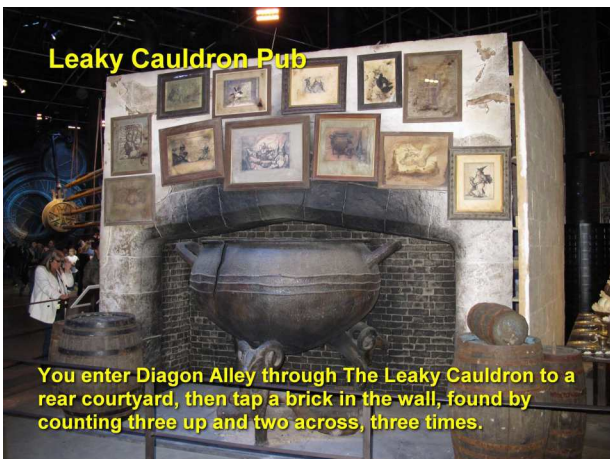

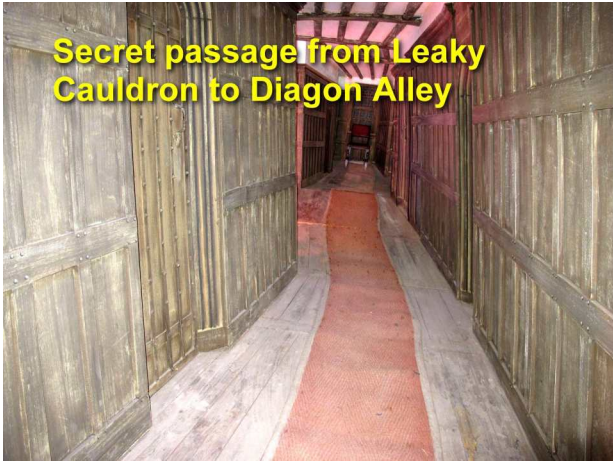
Leaky Cauldron Pub

You enter Diagon Alley through The Leaky Cauldron to a rear courtyard, then tap a brick in the wall, found by counting three up and two across, three times.

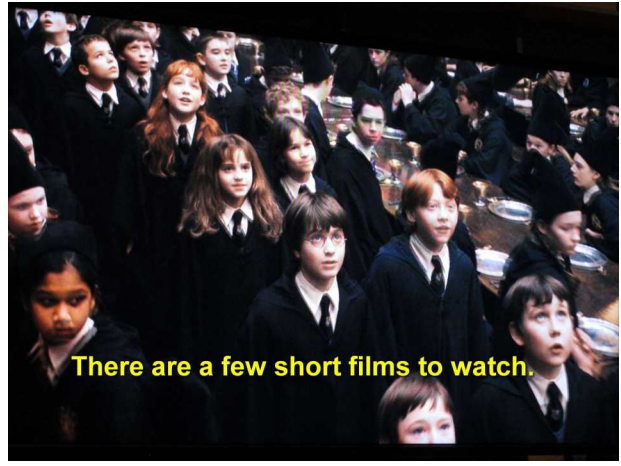


Why it's called Leaky Cauldron

A "cauldron" is a large metal pot for cooking over an open fire.



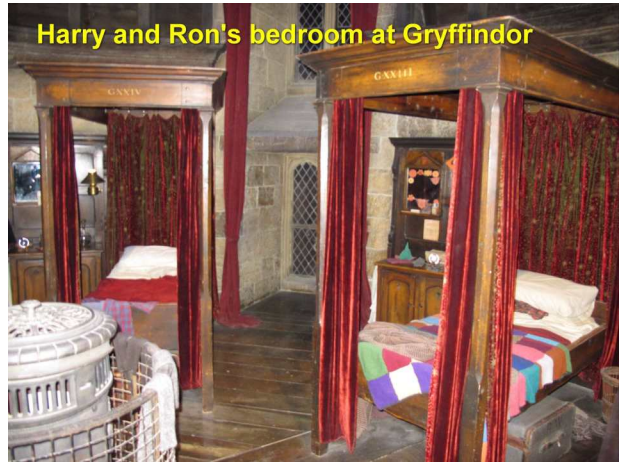

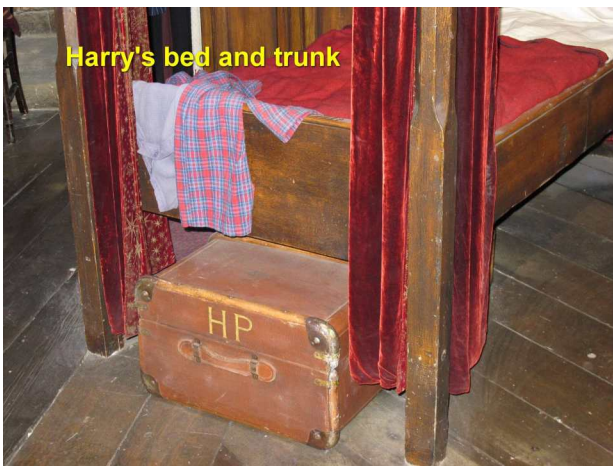

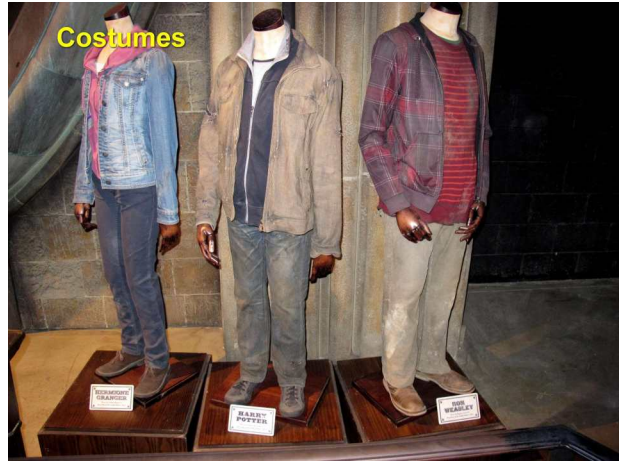
Different types of wands

More than 3000 wands were made for the films, using combinations of wood, plastic, resin and rubber.

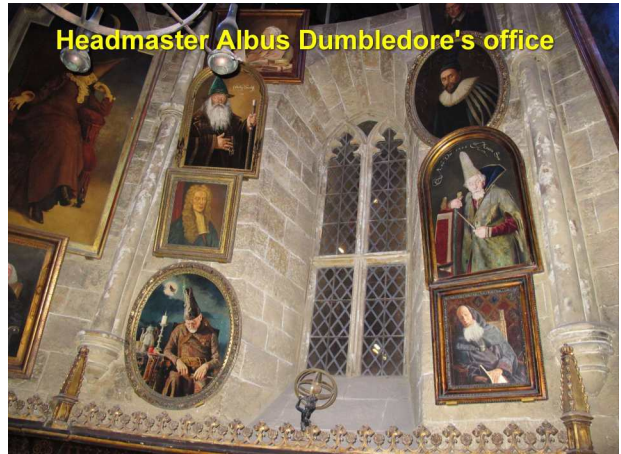
WANDS
More than 3000 wands were made for the films, using combinations of wood, plastic, resin and rubber. The first designs were ornate, bejewelled versions; however, J.K. Rowling suggested to the prop department that the wands should instead be made of wood construction, and designed to a specific length and shape that would complement the wizard who owned it. As Ollivander the wandmaker said, 'it's really the wand that chooses the wizard...'



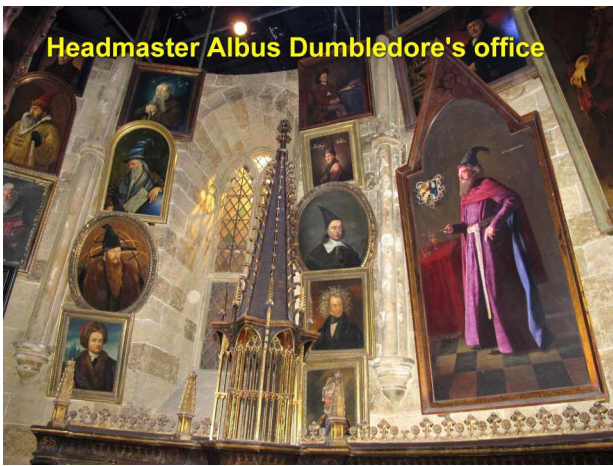
