

- Fishing permit is not needed.
- Beach, showers, rest rooms.
- Cosmos Pizza Concession 9am to Sunset.

# Naples Pier History - Slide 1 of 3

- Original 600-foot pier built in 1889 by the Naples Company. Passenger and freight dock where goods, mail, and people arrived by boat from Punta Gorda to Naples. T-shaped.
- Pier had footpath plus tram on rails to take goods to town.
- In those days, 12th Ave South was named Pier Street.


1960 Hurricane Donna, total destruction.


2017 Hurricane Irma.


 Also major reconstruction in 1995 and 2015.


## Naples Pier History – Slide 3 of 3


- Hurricane Irma Sept 2017:
  - Pier closed until August 2018.
  - About \$200,000 damages.
- Naples's first post office was located at the end of the pier before it was destroyed by an accidental cigarette fire in 1922.



















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
















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
