The Keewaydin Club (Privately Owned) Resort and Cottages on the Island
1934-1999 there was private Keewaydin Club with cottages and shuttle ferry from Port Royal, Naples, to north tip of Keewaydin.
Ferry (Kokomis) is now on exhibit at Collier County Museum.

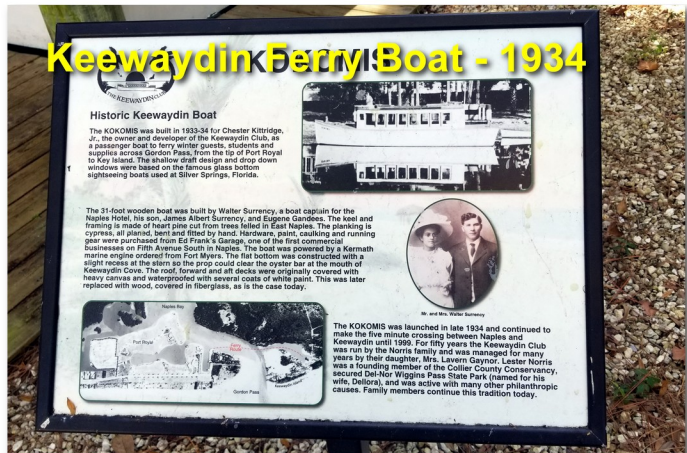
