Where: 950 Dunlop Road, Sanibel, FL.
Get There: Cross Sanibel Causeway. Right on Periwinkle 2.5 miles.
When: Mid-October through April (Seasonal): Tues.-Sat. 10 am to 4 pm.
 May through July (Summer): Tues.-Sat. 10 am to 1 pm.
Admission: \$10.00 adults. Children free.

What: The story of Sanibel from the Calusa and Spanish eras to the early pioneer families who settled on the island in the 1800s.

The 11 buildings loaded with historical artefacts and photos tell of warriors, adventures, fishermen, farmers, and proprietors.

Nine historic buildings moved from their original sites. Each restored to its original state. And replica packing house and garage:

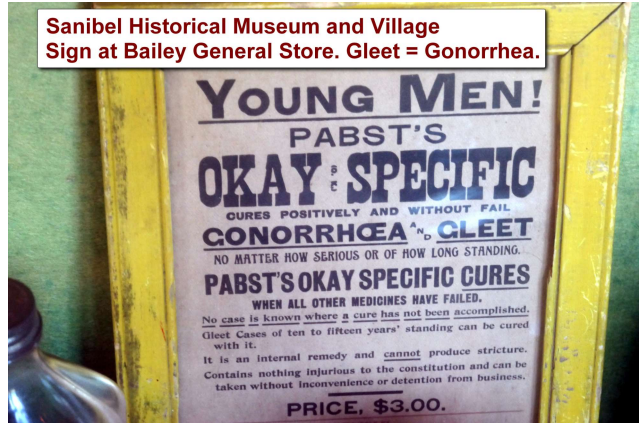
- Shore Haven (1924).

- Morning Glories Cottage (1925).
- Sanibel Packing House (1900)
- Sanibel School House (1896).
- Post Office (1926).
- Burnap Cottage (1898).
- Miss Charlotta's Tea Room (1926).
- Rutland House (1913).



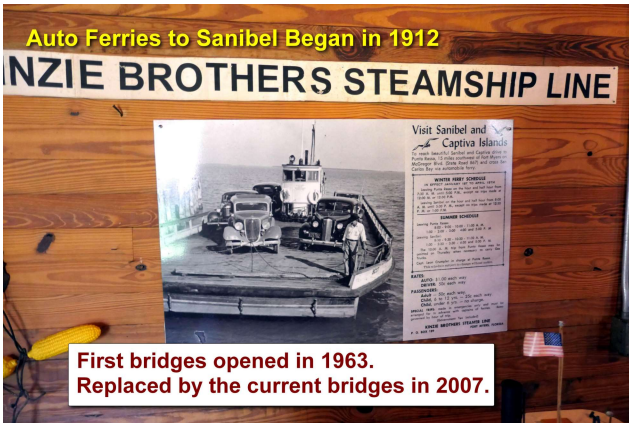


Sanibel Historical Museum and Village

This is the Bailey Brothers' second store. The first one was destroyed in a massive hurricane in 1926.

Late 19th c and early 20th c Sanibel was a farming community.

Built by Bailey Brothers at the Ferry Dock as a Temporary Store

Miss C was the maiden aunt of the Bailey Bros.

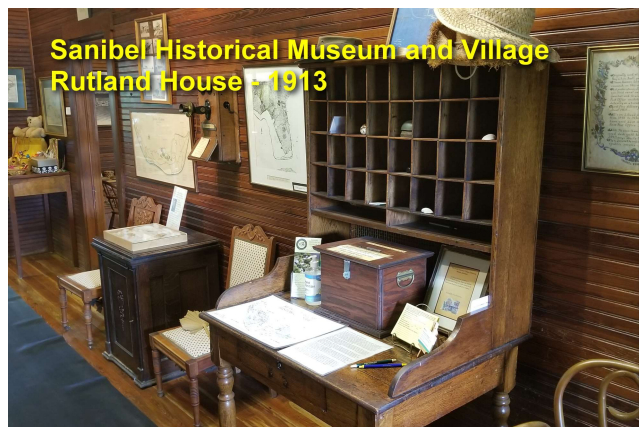
