What:

- 1,000-foot historic fishing pier.
- Bird watching, dolphin spotting.
- Fishing permit is not needed.
- Beach, showers, rest rooms.
- Cosmos Pizza Concession 9am to Sunset.

Naples Pier History - Slide 1

- Original 600-foot pier built in 1889 by the Naples Company. Passenger and freight dock where goods, mail, and people arrived by boat from Punta Gorda to Naples. T-shaped.
- Pier had footpath plus tram on rails to take goods to town.
- In those days, 12th Ave South was named Pier Street.






















Damage Caused by Hurricane lan September 28, 2022



Naples Pier - Hurricane Ian Update as of December 2024.

- 30 pilings collapsed.
- Half the pier is missing.
- New pier: \$24.6 million.
 - FEMA expected to pay about \$14m.
- Contract awarded to Shoreline Foundation, West Park, Florida, but that work can't start until the final signoffs from federal agencies.
