In my free time, I enjoy relaxing at our cabin in Ladysmith, spending quality time with my grandkids, baking, and crafting.

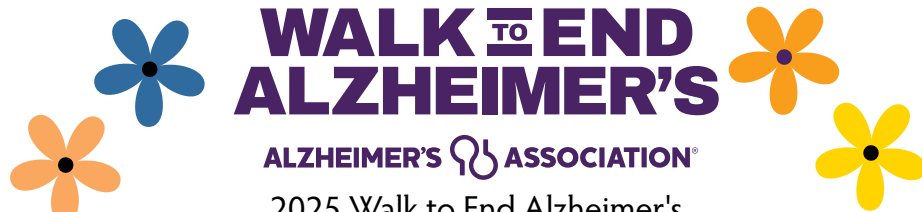

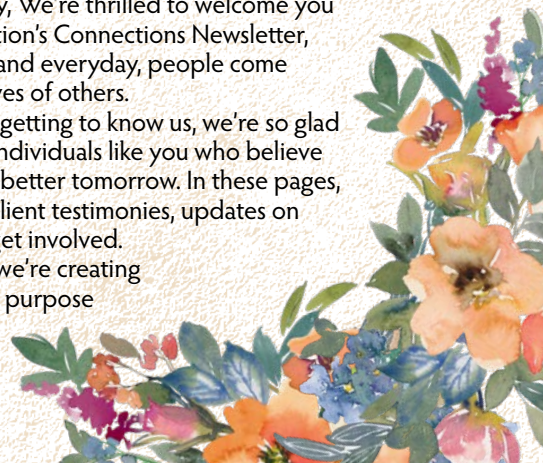
## A Note from Interfaith

Giving Voice is a well-known memory choir in Minnesota that has recognized Interfaith along with four other rural Wisconsin organizations to start this initiative.
