Son's Island Booking Instructions:

1. Click in the Start Date area

Tip: Be sure to use a desktop computer or an android device or the availability calendar will not pop up. Available days will be highlighted on the calendar in green.

2. Select the day you would like to arrive.

Select when you would like to enjoy the Island by clicking on "See Listings" when hovering over the option you would like to choose:

- a. Daytime Cabana Rental,
- b. Evening Rental or
- c. Glamping (short for overnight glamour camping)

Tip: If you plan to rent a daytime cabana and glamping, start with the daytime rental first, you will have the option to add camping or evening rental later in the process. Available Cabanas will be listed first and will have a "Book Now" button.

3. Select the Cabana you would like by clicking on the "Book Now" Button

Note: All the cabanas are amazing and wonderful and are the same price. The main difference is the depth of the water at each cabana. On average, cabanas:

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#A-1 - #A-10 are 6' - 8' deep

#A11-A-19 are 2' - 4' deep with rocky bottom

#B1 - B9 are 4' - 6' deep

#C1 - C6 are 6' - 8' deep
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Please Note: We are on a natural lake and the depths vary & change, please use caution and common sense when entering the water. Each cabana has a private dock with ladder to safely enter and exit the water, please use. Never dive or jump in as there could be an unseen rock or stump hidden in the water.

Note: If you plan to rent multiple cabanas, you will have the option to do so later, for now, start with one.

4. Enter the total number of people who plan to come.

Entry for 8 people are included with the price of a daytime or evening cabana rental. Kids 2 and under are free.

5. If you have a promo code or voucher, click "Apply Promo Code or Voucher" in bottom left corner" Enter code and click Apply.

We do run discounts & specials from time to time. To sign up & receive our specials, subscribe by entering your e-mail address on our Specials page.

- 6. Click Continue
- 7. By clicking on the + sign by the corresponding item, you have the option to add:
 - a. Tent camping (Glamping)
 - i. Select your check in and check out date and add to booking.
 - b. Watercraft wristbands
 - i. Select, adjust quantity and add to booking.
 Watercraft wristbands allow you to select any kayak or paddleboard at the kayak station, use for up to 45 min & then return to the kayak station. You can do this as many times as you like. Each person must have a wristband to use.
 - c. You also have the option to rent and keep at your cabana all day, a 1 or 2-seater kayak, paddleboard or I-float (a large floating mat that kids like to play on and adults love to lounge on).
- 8. If you would like to add another cabana or anything else, click on the green "+Add to Booking" in the upper left area and repeat the process above. Click on the clear button to start your booking over. If you need help of have and questions, please call us at: 888-993-6772

Most Commonly Asked Questions:

What is Son's Island?

Son's Island is an actual Island located approx. 11 miles east of New Braunfels in Lake Placid which is part of the Guadalupe River. At Son's Island you can rent lakeside Cabanas with private docks by the day, evening or stay overnight in one of our glamping (glamour camping) setups! You can also kayak, paddleboard, play beach volley ball, swim, slide and more!

How much does it cost to rent a cabana?

On average from \$99 - \$245 per day which includes entry for 8 people. Prices vary depending on the day and season, with weekdays during the fall or spring being the least expensive and holidays weekends in the summer being the most. Can we bring more than 8 people?

You can have a maximum of 15 people per cabana, each additional person, after 8, is \$10 - \$25 extra per person on average depending on the day & season. Holiday prices are more.

What activities are included when renting a Cabana?

Swimming, fishing (bring your own gear), beach volleyball, boat docking (you may bring your own boat and dock at no additional charge) water slide, cornhole, resting in one of the many hammocks on the island and barbecuing!

Must you have a reservation?

Can we bring our own food and drinks including alcohol?

Yes, grilling by the lake and enjoying a cold beverage is part of the fun at son's Island! No glass though!

Can we drive to the island by car?

Yes! No need to bring a boat as we have a 100-foot-long wooden bridge that you can drive a car across.

Where do we park? Is there a limit to how many vehicles we can bring?

We have parking on the island, but **we limit the parking to two cars for each cabana.** If you have additional cars, we now have a lot nearby with golf cart shuttle. The cost is \$20 per vehicle.

Can we bring our own kayaks, boats, jet skis and/or floats?

Yes, you are welcome to bring any of these items yourself.

Are pets allowed?

No, we love pets but unfortunately our insurance does not allow them to be on the Island.

Can you pay for glamping and come during the day time?

No, the times you pay for are the times you can use the Island.

Are there alligators, snakes and spiders?

There are no monster or small alligators in Lake Placid. Anywhere in Texas you can find snakes and spiders and Son's Island is no exception though we don't have more here than other places. When you are outdoors, it is always best to use caution and avoid weedy and

heavily brushed areas and stay to lighted paths at night. We have never had a guest bitten by a snake and have had tens of thousands of visitors to Son's Island.

Is the water level low?

No, we are on a constant level lake. In 2018 the water level did drop due to work the government was doing on the dam, but the water level is back to normal.

Is the water clear/blue?

Son's Island is an actual Island in Lake Placid which is fed by the Guadalupe River. As with any natural body of water, the color does change depending on the amount of rain, sunlight etc. After a hard rain or flood the water can look muddy brown. If we haven't had a hard rain in a while the particles settle, and the water turns a beautiful blue!

How deep is the water? What is the bottom like?

Son's Island is just under 4 acres and has almost a mile of lakefront. The depth varies depending on where you are at and range from 2' - 12' deep. The bottom varies as well, some areas have a rocky bottom, others a muddy bottom.

I noticed some bad reviews.

We do not filter our reviews at all. I'm not sure exactly how many 5-star reviews we have but I'd imagine for each bad review we have about a 100 5-star reviews. Some people you can't please no matter what. Everyone else seems to have a blast at Son's Island!

Do you only offer glamping?
