It would seem that experience in life should long since have made this clear and comprehensible to everyone, but Alas! engulfed in the depths of sinful life, led about by diabolical pride and culpable self-love, self-confident people, who put their trust in themselves alone, easily forget the lessons which life itself teaches them, and no matter how many blows they receive in the course of their existence, whereby the Lord Himself instructs them, nevertheless it is frequent among them that, as God's Word instructs us, 'according to the true proverb, the dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire' (2 Ptr 2:22)."
