

Walking With God

The way senses work is the way revelation is going to work. If the human body carries all those systems and all that diversity, then the spirit has to reflect at least the same amount of diversity.

In revelation the registering apparatus is the spiritual senses, but it's in the mind of Christ where we know. Situations are going to look the same, but God is going to indicate to you by revelation by the five spiritual senses that your situation is distinctively unique. You're going to see it, hear it, taste it, touch it, or smell it—it's the process of that inner nature.

Jesus Christ by foretelling said that spirit has been "with you, and shall be in you" [John 14:17]. Jesus Christ did not know the Mystery, and yet he faithfully spoke forth the revelation God gave him. Now we see how precise and accurate that was [John 16:13, 14].

That inner essence is spirit behind all those frameworks and systems of the human body—from toes to head. You start building in your mind in terms of these manifestations of revelation the perspective that this whole inner man is one big receiving station, receiving whatever impulses, energizings, directions, that God gives you by way of that inner nature.

We register by our senses, and we recognize by our thought patterns. We have the mind of Christ, and that's where it registers spiritually and then communicates to our cognizant awareness. All of that is dependent upon our walk in the light as He is Light. If I'm out of fellowship, out of alignment and harmony, then all of this is negated until I line my thoughts back up with the written Scripture or the spoken Word that I need to humble myself to and get back in line.

The intricacy behind the human body is so reflected in the intricacy of the inner-essence nature. God has designed that spirit to specifically fit your body, your mind, your genetic makeup. That gift is your gift. Then you have the wonderful adventure of discovering the experiential reality of how the Father impresses His will upon your inner nature that communicates to your mind that you can clearly carry out the will of the Father according to your desire and willingness to please Him.

Anything you've learned something from, you're going to utilize if you live long enough and walk for God. You're going to need everything God has provided for you—great learning in your background, great learning in your family, athletics, academics. It's the Word that helps us appreciate all that more deeply.

If my need and the need of my decision making can be supplied by my knowledge of the written Word, by my previous learning in life, or by my vigilant observation, then I don't need revelation.
