

## Fifty Tips for “Living in God’s Creation”

1. God never wanted to be viewed as a limited image.  
Isa 55:8, 9 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.  
You can trust God implicitly. He’s omnipotent (all powerful), omniscient (all knowing), and omnipresent (everywhere present).
2. It’s not negatives that get you to the Word it’s your humility at the time.  
Humility is against self-importance, its recognition of self in relation to God and subsequent submission. 1Pe 5:5-7 Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble. Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time: Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you =humility.
3. Share resources with believers across the land, nourishing one another. Since Jesus Christ embodies the fullness of God’s divine nature in us, we have much to share with each other. We can never live long enough to know everything; therefore, we glean as much as possible from others and share from a pool of knowledge and wisdom.
4. There is safety in a multitude of counselors.  
Pro 11:14 Where no counsel is, the people fall: but in the multitude of counsellors there is safety.
5. If you try to be everything you won’t be anything. There is not enough time in life to be everything or to know everything. Specialize your gift in you and don’t compare II Cor. 10:12.
6. Long suits come out as we’re DOING.
7. Be versatile, you can under do or over do anything. Don’t allow your long suits to work against you. Temper them with the Word. (Boundaries)
8. In the moment you need, in your weakness, God’s strength is there.  
2Co 12:9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness.
9. You’re always overcoming when you’re in the Word.
10. Be solution oriented not problem oriented.
11. You can get your leg pulled by great personalities and abilities that impress you. You must love God and His Word more and you will recognize.
12. People that are blind are so sincere.
13. Don’t make a friend to anything that brings fear. Fear always has excuses for not acting on the Word. It’s a device against your mind and it has multifarious disguises. If someone wants to get delivered, they must get honest about their fear.
14. Clearly identify evil so it can be avoided. God will make us wiser than our enemies.
15. Being not afraid, keeps you complete.
16. Lose your life in the Word, in service (Matt 16:25) and you will find your true self and you will see that God will satisfy you!
17. Carnal Christians elevate natural knowledge above spiritual.
18. Peter said he had forsaken all and followed Jesus. Those things that are secondary. In this life and in the one to come there are hundred-fold blessings and rewards. They come as you’re faithful, but you don’t put those blessings first, God is your source of supply.
19. When you’re abased you still have your needs met, you just don’t have as much to work with.  
Phil 4:12-13 I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: everywhere and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. I can do all things

through Christ which strengtheneth me.

20. If your ministry is going to be energized in you, you must love the Word more than any! Keep yourself nourished.
21. Grow out of the comfort zone and keep learning.
22. Obedience starts with listening. If we can't take orders from people, we'll have a rough time taking them from God, because God whispers a lot softer.
23. Receiving information from God is a "fresh thought."
24. Every time you can speak the Word, it's a new beginning.
25. There's a fine line between pleasing people and doing what God wants you to do. You can go overboard with anything.
26. Certain things you'll never understand until you act.
27. You don't provide hobbies to avoid your responsibility, you have them to provide a necessary relaxing aspect to your body and mind so you're ready to get back in the "game."
28. You can't have wisdom without knowledge. You will or won't do something if you have knowledge of what can happen. Wisdom is the right door.
29. Partner with God don't do His part.
30. If people have ability, encourage them, they need to learn to apply themselves. Show the people how to maximize their ability.
31. God may not show you everything all at once. If God told us everything it would be no adventure.
32. The path of God is marked with good fruit.
33. Circumstances don't dictate who we are.
34. What people are capable of handling is what you go by in raising up disciples.
35. Learn your heart and mind. You can't let things get to your believing heart, whether it's bad news or anything.
36. It takes endurance to wait for a "green light" before acting.
37. Sometimes you must wait for years for certain things to come to pass. It doesn't mean God is saying "NO," the timing just isn't there. Variables need to come together, timing is everything. You must have that kind of discipline and restraint at times, that equilibrium in the waiting period.
38. In different seasons of life God opens doors for growth. Seasons of life have different priorities.
39. Great teachers inspire us to go where we would never go on our own.
40. As believers it's our responsibility to insure freewill.
41. You don't look at people as failures. If they have weaknesses, they have a need. See their long suits and bring those out.
42. Separate the person from the sin. Christianity is a judgment free zone.
43. Have empathy for people. Deliverance is a great builder of believing and ability.
44. Leaders are not solace, but disturbers and awakeners. Ships are safe in a harbor, but ships aren't made to stay still.
45. There's an art to moving people into new beliefs to make it comfortable for them. Persuasion is the opposite of coercion.
46. Vision is dreaming the great dreams and direction is the practical daily hands on tasks.
47. Plan your life considering eternity.
48. God takes care of our past and future so we can live in the moment.
49. Jesus Christ is experiencing God, there is no time measurement in eternity. God inhabits eternity (Isa. 57:15) and we need eternity to get to know God. Joh 17:3 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.
50. Celebrate daily with a merry heart. It's good medicine and you will have a continual feast. (Prov. 17:22; 15:15)
