## **ABOUT THE MEETING:**

**"After the Active Shooter."** There have been conferences, discussions and seminars on conducting yourselves and knowing what to do if there is an active shooter at your location. However, much work and effort is needed to get your organization back to "normal" after the event is done. **Major Larry Moser (Ret.)** will discuss different considerations to address your organization's response after an active shooter, including accounting for personnel welfare and health,

location and building repair considerations, insurance, and other topics of interest.

The second half of the meeting will be a Q&A with Major Moser.

### **GUEST SPEAKER:**

**Larry Moser** served as law enforcement officer for 28 years, accomplishing the rank of Major while serving the Fairfax County Virginia Police Department (FCPD). Larry has provided professional development training to more than 100 law enforcement agencies nationwide. His audiences range from frontline personnel to senior managers.

During his FCPD tenure his ability to bring diverse service partners together allowed him to serve on a CDC and DOJ national work-groups developing model policy for joint public health and law enforcement investigations of Bioterrorism incidents. He also contributed to the Police Executive Research Forum's Guide to Occupational Health and Safety for Law Enforcement Executives. Larry brings practical and leadership continuity of operations experience having led safety and security initiatives targeting County-wide safety after an active-shooter took the lives of two officers at their workplace. Larry strives to accomplish immediate student engagement instilling leadership, interpersonal communication skills and high-quality professional service.

He is further honored to have been selected to brief the Honorable Janet Reno (former United States Attorney General) as she prepared to argue before the Supreme Court in the case of Maryland v. Wilson. His training accomplishments have received recognition as the Greater Washington, DC area Trainer of the Year, Distinguished Trainer award, two Meritorious Service awards, multiple team excellence awards, and Police Officer of the Year.
