Focus Groups

We are beginning to activate our Focus Groups which have all been inactive for the past 6 months. We developed these groups to enable us to maximize our potential to achieve our mission to create a climate of kindness in our community and beyond. We will have sign-up lists for those of you who would like to join any of these at our meeting. These are the Focus Groups:

Candidate Selection and Event Coordination Group

The purpose of this group is to oversee the selection of candidates who have shown exceptional kindness for acknowledgment, and to plan these events. We hope to have at least one of these events each month.

Education Focus group

This group will communicate with schools in the tri-county area (Sumter, Lake, and Marion) to explore ways to use our ideas and processes to get students involved in kindness. In the future we may expand well beyond these boundaries. The future is with our children – just think of the effect this can have!

This group has already begun their work, and Margaret Wolf will tell us about it at our meeting.

Business Flier Focus Group
