### Day 5

O Christ, before Your passion and death you revealed the resurrection to your disciples on Mount Tabor. Today, we pray for Your church which labors amid the cares and anxieties of this world. May it be transfigured by the joy of Your victory. Amen.

### Day 6

O Christ, You took Peter, James and John and led them up a high mountain by themselves. We pray today for Pope Francis and all bishops that they may also be inspired by the hope of being transfigured on the last day. Amen.

### Day 7

O Christ, You gave light to the world when the glory of the Creator was revealed in You. We pray today for all persons to see how they walk in Your light. Amen.

### Day 8

O Christ, upon the mountaintop You let the light of your face shine over Moses and Elijah. We ask Your blessing upon Your people who call on Your name, who want to belong to your kingdom of light and life. Amen.

### Day 9

# The Feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord

## August 6, 2021

### History of the Devotion

All three Synoptic Gospels tell the story of the Transfiguration (*Matthew 17:1-8; Mark 9:2-9; Luke 9:28-36*). With remarkable agreement, all three place the event shortly after Peter's confession of faith that Jesus is the Messiah and Jesus' first prediction of his passion and death. Peter's eagerness to erect tents or booths on the spot suggests it occurred during the week-long Jewish Feast of Booths in the fall. Tradition names Mount Tabor as the site of the revelation.

The earliest testimony of the association of Mount Tabor with the miracle of the Transfiguration is in the third century writings of Origen. It is also mentioned by St. Cyril of Jerusalem and St. Jerome in the fourth century.

A church that was first raised there in the fourth century was dedicated on August 6. A feast in honor of the Transfiguration was celebrated in the Eastern Church from about that time. Western observance began in some localities about the eighth century.

On July 22, 1456, Crusaders defeated the Turks at Belgrade. News of the victory reached Rome on August 6, and Pope Callistus III placed the feast on the Roman calendar the following year.

### Reflection on The Transfiguration & Psalm 104 - Praise of God the Creator

In Psalm 104 God's wondrous creation is revealed as written in Genesis. In the New Testament, Jesus reveals how He cooperates in the ongoing work of creation and our salvation in the Transfiguration.

Let's imagine ourselves walking up the mountain with Jesus, Peter and James and John to pray. The day is warm but gentle breezes flow down, cooling our faces. Alongside the path is a clear stream winding dutifully down to the valley below. Jesus sets a brisk pace- we hurry to keep up.

Arriving at the top of the mountain, Jesus calls us to all kneel. As He begins to pray the Psalm: Lord, my God, you are great indeed! flocks of birds begin to settle in the fragrant trees, their joyful songs filling the air, branches dancing in rhythm. Forest creatures gather around. God's own symphony, His creation, joins with Jesus and the Holy Spirit in praise of God's majesty and power.

Suddenly, all around us the light becomes intense. We see Jesus shining brightly from within, the joy of creation radiating from His very face. We hear God's booming voice from a cloud, commanding us to listen to Jesus. Then Jesus and the mountain return to normal. He leads the way back down. We are quiet, reflecting on the burning love in our hearts.

## Feast of St. Clare

### August 11



St. Clare was a noble woman of the Italian town of Assisi at the end of the 12th and the beginning of the 13th centuries. Inspired by the preaching of her contemporary St. Francis of Assisi, Clare left her family home and followed Francis in giving herself to living a poor, simple, Gospel life at the little church of San Damiano on the outskirts of Assisi. Soon, her sister Agnes and others joined her. They lived a simple life of great poverty, austerity, and complete seclusion from the world, according to a Rule which Francis gave them as a Second Order. At age 21, Francis obliged Clare under obedience to accept the office of abbess, one she exercised until her death.

Contemporary accounts glow with admiration of Clare's life in the convent of San Damiano in Assisi. She served the sick and washed the feet of the begging nuns. She came from prayer, it was said, with her face so shining it dazzled those about her. She suffered serious illness for the last 27 years of her life. Her influence was such that popes, cardinals, and bishops often came to consult her – Clare herself never left the walls of San Damiano. Francis always remained her great friend and inspiration.

A well-known story concerns her prayer and trust. Clare had the Blessed Sacrament placed on the walls of the convent when it faced attack by invading Saracens. “Does it please you, O God, to deliver into the hands of these beasts the defenseless children I have nourished with your love? I beseech you, dear Lord, protect these whom I am now unable to protect.” To her sisters she said, “Don’t be afraid. Trust in Jesus.” The Saracens fled. St. Clare is considered the Patron Saint of television and eye disorders.
