A 9 DAY NOVENA TO OUR LADY OF Betharram

Introduction

There are times when we feel a great need for prayer. Frequently this arises from deep within which leads us the experience of conversion. Throughout history, we find a great devotion and prayer brought us together in prayer for the good of the humanity. In this time of pandemic, we are called to make a 9 day Novena in honour of Our Lady of Betharram to ask for Mary's protection on our parish communities and all who participate in this novena.

St. Michael Garicoits and Our Lady

For Michael, the veneration of the Blessed Virgin Mary was an essential part of his spirituality. At crucial points in his life, Michael had recourse to her intercession. At the shrine of Our Lady of Betharram, Saint Michael Garicoits received inspiration to found a new religious institute. Like him we shall find in the Virgin Mary a wonderful model of a life consecrated to God, "always disposed to do what God wanted and willing to submit to all God did". (SCJ Rule of Life 12)

Betharramites and Our Lady

Betharram, which means BEAUTIFUL BRANCH, is an ancient Marian shrine of pilgrimage. As a young girl, St. Bernadette was often a visitor. Young father Michael was appointed chaplain of the shrine in 1825. He founded the SCJ congregation in 1835. The Betharramites have always turned to Our Lady for protection and care, especially in times of crisis. Following Saint Michael Garicoits' example, we, SCJ fathers and brothers love with a filial love the Blessed Virgin Mary, who was implicated in the mystery of the Word becoming Flesh. We express our love for her (...) by celebrating her feasts, notably those of the Annunciation and of our Lady of Betharram." (SCJ Rule of Life n. 92, C)

A Novena

With the examples of St. Michael Garicoits in mind, it is only right that we SCJ communities and parishes where SCJ serves in England turn to Our Lady of Betharram during this pandemic. These 9 days of frequent repetition of our calling on our Lord and his Mother for help increases our faith, hope, and love. It brings us into closer union with God and makes us more ready to do God's will rather than our own. We turn to Our Lady in prayer with confidence, knowing that the love she had for her Son extends to us as well.

The texts for each day below offers the fullest form of this Novena to Our Lady of Betharram. It may be prayed communally or individually. Recognizing that it may not be possible in all circumstances to participate in this full form, one may simply offer each day the prayer composed by Saint Pope Pius X was known to be devoted to Our Lady of Betharram. He offered her two magnificent golden crowns made up of branches woven together. This prayer accompanying the inscription stated:

"May the Son and His Mother accept our gifts and by appeasing our hopes and desires may they keep for us one day the crown of glory which none can tarnish." Amen

We turn to Our Lady of Betharram in prayer as all of us seek to find this Novena to Our Lady's protection and care. As a way to demonstrate our love, we make three promises to Our Lady Betharram as a part of this Novena:

- 1) To keep a perpetual lamp burning during the Novena days before the image of Our Lady Betharram in our parishes. (The Sacred Heart and St Catherine of Alexandria, Droitwich; Olton Friary Parish, Solihull; Holy Name Great Barr, Our Lady & Saint Werburgh, Clayton and Our Lady & Saint John the Baptist, Ashley; Corpus Christi Clifton and Our lady and St Patrick's, Meadows)
- 2) To celebrate annually the Feast of Our Lady of Betharram with great solemnity.
- 3) To promote devotion to Our Lady of the Betharram.

By living into these promises, we hope that our parishes will become a place where people of all walks of life will experience Mary's loving care and protection, just as St. Michael Garicoits did throughout his own life.

Day 1 INTENTION OF THE DAY: For the grace to do the will of God.

The Word took our nature from Mary

From a letter of St Athanasius

The Word took to himself the sons of Abraham, says the Apostle, and so had to be like his brothers in all things. He had then to take a body like ours. This explains the fact of Mary's presence: she is to provide him with a body of his own, to be offered for our sake. Scripture records her giving birth, and says: *She wrapped him in swaddling clothes.* Her breasts, which fed him, were called blessed. Sacrifice was offered because the child was her firstborn. Gabriel used careful and prudent language when he announced his birth. He did not

speak of "what will be born *in* you" to avoid the impression that a body would be introduced into her womb from outside; he spoke of "what will be born *from* you," so that we might know by faith that her child originated within her and from her.

The mystery of man's reconciliation with God From a letter of Saint Leo the Great, pope

He took the nature of a servant without stain of sin, enlarging our humanity without diminishing his divinity. He emptied himself; though invisible he made himself visible, though Creator and Lord of all things he chose to be one of us mortal men. Yet this was the condescension of compassion, not the loss of omnipotence. So he who in the nature of God had created man, became in the nature of a servant, man himself.

Thus the Son of God enters this lowly world. He comes down from the throne of heaven, yet does not separate himself from the Father's glory. He is born in a new condition, by a new birth.

He was born in a new condition, for, invisible in his own nature, he became visible in ours. Beyond our grasp, he chose to come within our grasp. Existing before time began, he began to exist at a moment in time. Lord of the universe, he hid his infinite glory and took the nature of a servant. Incapable of suffering as God, he did not refuse to be a man, capable of suffering. Immortal, he chose to be subject to the laws of death.

He who is true God is also true man. There is no falsehood in this unity as long as the lowliness of man and the pre-eminence of God coexist in mutual relationship.

'Christus Vivit' Pope Francis

'We are always struck by the strength of the young Mary's 'yes', the strength in those words, 'be it done', that she spoke to the angel. This was no merely passive or resigned acceptance, or a faint 'yes', as if to say, 'Well, let's give it a try and see what happens'. Mary did not know the words, 'Let's see what happens'. She was determined; she knew what was at stake and she said 'yes' without thinking twice. Hers was the 'yes' of someone prepared to be committed, someone willing to take a risk, ready to stake everything she had, with no more security than the certainty of knowing that she was the bearer of a promise. So I ask each one of you: do you see yourselves as the bearers of a promise? What promise is present in my heart that I can take up? Mary's mission would undoubtedly be difficult, but the challenges that lay ahead were no reason to say 'no'. Things would get complicated, of course, but not in the same way as happens when cowardice paralyzes us because things are not clear or sure in advance. Mary did not take out an insurance policy! She took the risk, and for this reason she is strong, she is an 'influencer', the 'influencer' of God. Her 'yes and her desire to serve were stronger than any doubts or difficulties'".
