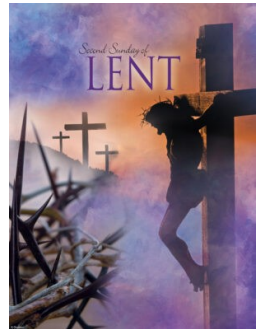

Dear Brothers and Sisters,
Every second Sunday of Lent, the Church reflects on the story of Jesus' transfiguration. In the presence of His three closest disciples, Jesus' glory as the Son of God shines through His human nature, and God the Father's voice is heard from the heavens: "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him!" We reflect on this story at this point every year during our Lenten journey so that we can be reminded that, when we embrace sacrifice and suffering, the power of God can shine through us. Saint Paul tells us in the Letter to the Romans that the sufferings of the present are as nothing compared to the glory which will be ours in Christ. When we accept our suffering with love and trust, we become more like Jesus. For this reason, we can even rejoice in the trials we face, because faith teaches us that our difficulties are transforming us more and more into the image and likeness of Christ.



All of us are his followers, his disciples, his co-workers who are called to become more like Jesus. The future is in our hands. We bring salvation and liberty to people's lives who are suffering at this moment. We have a responsibility to transform our world. In walking in his way, in doing all of the ordinary things, in a very Christian and Christ like way, we can change our world. We are extraordinary people and yet like Peter, James and John, we don't understand, we don't know. We are, however, like Abraham being called in quiet faith to venture out into the unknown.
