Dear Brothers and Sisters,

On this Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. The patronal feast day of Corpus Christi Parish community. Pope Urban IV instituted the feast of Corpus Christi in 1264 with the issue of the papal bull 'Transiturus'. This was the very first papally-sanctioned universal feast of the Latin rite. The pope requested the 'angelic doctor' Thomas Aquinas (1225-1274) to compose the liturgical prayers for the feast, which resulted in the composition of some of the finest hymns to the Blessed Sacrament including

Tantum ergo, Panis angelicus and *Pange lingua*, which are sung worldwide till today. Some of the sayings of great saints shall be our reflections as we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. They are as follows;

"When you approach the tabernacle remember that he has been waiting for you for twenty centuries." - St. Josemaria Escriva.

"If angels could be jealous of men, they would be so for one reason: Holy Communion." - St. Maximilian Kolbe.

"There is nothing so great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious, He would have given it to us." - St John Vianney

Happy Father's Day to all fathers, grandfathers, and stepfathers. 12 weeks ago, we observed Mother's Day and offered Mass for our mothers. Today, on this Father's Day, we are doing the same – offering our dads, living or dead, on the altar of God during the Holy Mass and invoking our Heavenly Father's blessings on them.
