Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Saint Peter and Saint Paul's feast day is celebrated on 29th June by the Church. Both Peter and Paul were friends of Jesus, but their lives were very different. Since 258, the solemnities of Saint Peter and Saint Paul have been celebrated on the same day. As St. Augustine of Hippo noted in a sermon in 395. Peter and Paul: "Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one. Peter went first, and Paul followed. And so we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostles' blood. Let us embrace what they believed, their life, their labours, their sufferings, their preaching, and their confession of faith."

Jesus entrusted apostles with the task of building the church and spreading the teachings of His gospel. We can all identify with both of these great Apostles. In the same way as Peter, we sometimes fail, but we persist nonetheless. Our task, like Paul's, must be to always proclaim the Lord no matter what, regardless of how challenging it may be. Through the grace of the Holy Spirit, we have the privilege of living and witnessing the Gospel entrusted to us by Jesus Christ. Just as a fisherman, Simon and a Pharisee, Saul became radiant with the divine grace through their repentance and steadfast dedication to Christ, the same can be true of us. Happy Feast Day of St. Peter and St. Paul. God Bless.
