## Rosuvastatin (Crestor®)

- Drug Class: HMG-CoA Reductase Inhibitor, Statin
- **Gene:** ABCG2
  - Variations in ABCG2 can lead to increased exposure to rosuvastatin
  - No dose changes are necessary when a person has two normal function alleles or if they have one variant allele
  - If two variant alleles are present, doses of rosuvastatin should not exceed 20 mg, and patients with increased needs should consider switching to a different statin or adding on another non-statin medication
  - This gene variant is most common in East Asians, with a prevalence of 30.71%
