Academic: Course content and expected student performance require reading and writing at a rigorous level Honors: Course content is paced with additional depth. Lessons are often designed to be complex, abstract, and open-ended.

• What's the difference between AP (Advanced Placement) and DE (Dual Enrollment) classes?

The Advanced Placement Program is a cooperative education endeavor with the College Board. AP courses allow students the opportunity to take college-level courses while they are enrolled in high school. Students who enroll in an AP course should expect extensive reading, writing, and critical thinking which generally require additional time. College and universities may award credit and/or special placement if a student earns a qualifying score on the exam given in May.

Participation in Dual Enrollment courses allow students to meet requirements for high school graduation while simultaneously earning college credits upon successful completion of the course. The transferability of a college course to another college or university is determined by the receiving institution.
