# Mutual Exchange application



Our scheme enables you to swap your home not only with St George Housing tenants, but any housing association or council tenant anywhere in the UK.

Please fill out this form if you have an exchange partner who you are ready to exchange with.

#### Both parties should read this before completing this application form

#### You can apply for an exchange if:

- You live in permanent, self-contained accommodation (e.g. a flat or a house); and
- Both of you have secure, flexible or assured tenancies;
- and
- Your landlord and the landlord of the home you want to move to has given you the permission to make the exchange.

### You are usually not entitled to an exchange if:

- You have a starter tenancy, an introductory tenancy, a demoted tenancy or an assured short hold tenancy; or
- You are a shared ownership leaseholder; or
- You live in supported accommodation.

### If you have not found a tenant to exchange with:

Contact your landlord to check if you can exchange your home. This is very important, as you may be evicted if you try to swap your home without permission.

You then need to register online with nationwide exchange website Homeswapper. Register online at: homeswapper.co.uk

## Why we may have to refuse your application

### All applicants in this exchange must read this carefully.

We may refuse your application if any of the following reasons apply. They are based on the reasons stated in the Housing Act 1985:

- 1. A court order has been made giving the landlord possession of the tenant's home.
- A notice seeking possession has been served on either the tenant or the person with whom the tenant wants to exchange the tenancy and the notice is still in force.
- 3. The tenant's home is substantially larger than is reasonably needed by the person with whom the tenant wants to exchange the tenancy.
- 4. The tenant's home would be too small for the needs of the person with whom the tenant wants to exchange the tenancy.
- 5. The home has been let to a tenant who was an employee of the landlord and the home is within the boundaries of an operational building or within a cemetery.
- 6. The landlord is a registered charity and the exchange would result in the new tenant's occupation conflicting with the purposes of the charity.
- 7. The home is designed or adapted to suit the needs of a physically disabled person and the exchange would result in it being occupied by someone without those needs.
- 8. The landlord is a housing trust that caters for people with special needs and the exchange would result in the home being occupied by someone without those needs.
- The home is in a group of homes let to people with special needs near some special facility (for example an old people's club) and the exchange would result in the home being occupied by someone without those needs.

Please do not exchange properties until both landlords have given you permission to do so.

#### **Important information**

Before a mutual exchange can go ahead, we will need further information on both properties.

We will request:

- a report from your landlord about your rent account and your tenancy record.
- a full internal and external survey of the property. You **MUST** inform us of any alterations i.e. kitchens, bathrooms. Any structural changes i.e. removal of walls or doors. Any changes to standard fittings i.e. lights etc.

If you are not sure about any changes you have made, we recommend you contact your landlord.

#### **Under-Occupation Charge**

If you have one 'spare' bedroom your housing benefit will be cut by 14% and if you have two or more 'spare' bedrooms you will lose 25%. If your benefit is cut you will have to pay your landlord the difference between your housing benefit and your rent. You will not be able to exchange to a property if you are affected by the under-occupation charge and cannot afford to meet the shortfall payment.

#### This could affect you if:

- you are of working age (aged 16 to 61 years old)
- you are only claiming a small amount of housing benefit because, for example, you are working
- even if you are sick or disabled.

#### This won't affect you if:

- you or your partner are old enough to receive pension credit
- you live in a shared ownership property, or sheltered or supported housing scheme
- you are a foster carer
- you are a parent of a teenager in the armed forces.
