



## 2022 Arizona Legislative Session Highlights

### HB2473 Firearms; Contracts; Prohibited Practices

A "public entity" (defined) is prohibited from entering into a contract with a value of \$100,000 or more with a company to acquire or dispose of services, supplies, information technology, or construction unless the contract includes a written certification that the company does not currently and agrees for the duration of the contract that it will not, discriminate against a "firearm entity" (defined).

**Sponsor: Rep. Carroll (R)**

**Status: Passed the House (31-28). Passed Senate Appropriations (6-4)**

### HB2637 Certain Affiliations; Banks; Prohibition

A financial institution doing business in Arizona, either directly or through a contractor, is prohibited from discriminating against any person based on a political affiliation or other social credit, environmental, social, governance or similar values-based or impact criteria.

**Status: Failed on Senate Floor (13-15)**

### SB1363 Foreign Country Judgements; Applicability

Makes conforming changes to the Arizona Foreign-Country Money Judgments Recognition Act. Does not prevent the recognition under principles of comity or otherwise of a foreign-country judgment that is not within the scope of the Act.

**Status: Passed Senate (28-0) Passed House (55-0)**

**Signed by Governor Ducey (4/19)**

**AzBA Position: Support**

### SB1461 Income Tax; FDIC Premiums

Requires, retroactive to taxable years beginning January 1, 2020, the amount of any Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) premiums paid or incurred by a taxpayer that is disallowed as a deduction for federal income tax purposes to be subtracted when computing a corporation's Arizona gross income.

**Sponsor: Sen. Livingston (R)**

**Status: Passed the Senate (19-9). Assigned to House Ways & Means**
