

Robert William Anderson

March 10, 1916 to September 27, 2007

Robert William Anderson, 91, of rural Queen City MO passed away on Thursday, September 27, 2007 at the Scotland County Care Center in Memphis MO where he had been a resident since April 24, 2007.

The son of Loring Henry and Cora Helen (Snowbarger) Anderson, he was born on March 10, 1916 in rural Queen City MO.
