

EMMA BARNES DIES AT KIRKSVILLE

A life long resident of Schuyler County, Emma Barnes, 83, of Lancaster, died in a Kirksville hospital this morning at 2:26.

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon at 2:30 in the St. Johns Lutheran Church, located northeast of Queen City. The services were conducted by Rev. James McMorrow of Ottumwa, Ia., and burial was in the Germania cemetery located near the church.

She was born in Schuyler county on April 27, 1867. In 1914 she was married to Joseph A. Barnes, he died in 1933.
