Albert, son of August and Caroline Bergman, was born in Schuyler County Missouri, May 31, 1868 and has lived his entire life in that vicinity.

He departed this life at the Grim-Smith Hospital at Kirksville, Mo. Dec. 24, 1936 at the age of 68 years, 6 months and 23 days. After having been bedfast for 8 weeks His death was attributed to heart disease.
