

Schuyler county has lost another of its soldier boys by the death of True Bergman who died at Camp Funston last Sunday, March 24. This is the second death of Schuyler county boys, the first being Chester Gatts who died at Camp Doniphan during the past winter. Bergman was a victim of pneumonia and his parents, who live about six miles south of Lancaster, were notified of his illness last Friday. His father, Lewis Bergman left immediately for Camp Funston to be at his bedside. The father returned to Queen City Tuesday morning with the body where it was met at the station by a large number of sorrowing friends and relatives. The schools and civic bodies assembled to do honor to the stricken soldier. True was one of the most popular boys of his locality and enjoyed the respect of a very large acquaintance. He was about twenty-four years old and left with the second contingent of boys sent to Camp Funston last fall.
