

Boyd Dean Figge, 84, of rural Lancaster, Missouri died at his home on Wednesday, May 23, 2001.

The son of Oran Washington and Louise Catherine (Bergman) Figge, he was born October 4, 1916 in rural Queen City, Missouri.

He was married to Mildred Garnet Schafer on September 20, 1949. She preceded him in death on November 25, 1986. Besides his parents and wife, a brother and sister, Lloyd and Mary who died in infancy and a sister, Berniece Miller, preceded him in death.

Mr. Figge, a life time resident of Schuyler County, was a farmer and a livestock producer. He worked for the Wabash Railroad for a short time prior to serving with the United States Army during World War II.

He is survived by his son, Howard Figge of the home; three brothers, Charles F. Figge of Centerville, Iowa, Raymond Figge of Ottumwa, Iowa and Russell Figge of Lancaster, Missouri; two sisters, Corinne Gemming of Camp Point, Illinois and Virginia Riggins of LaPlata, Missouri; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, May 26, 2001 at the Norman Funeral Home in Lancaster, Missouri at 2:00 p.m. A visitation for family and friends will begin at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday.
