

Final Rites For Oran W. Figge

Oran Washington Figge, 87 of Queen City, Mo., died at 3:30 p.m. Sunday afternoon, November 21, 1970 in a Kirksville, Mo., hospital where he had been a patient since October 31st.

The son of John Henry and Elizabeth (Figge) Figge, he was born seven miles east of Queen City, Mo., on June 26, 1883. On February 16, 1911 at Queen City, Mo., he married Louise Bergman who preceded him in death on July 31, 1968. Also preceding him in death were one son and one daughter, both in infancy; one brother and three sisters.

Surviving are seven children, Mrs. Alfred (Bernice) Miller of Queen City, Mrs. John (Corinne) Gemming of Basco, Ill., Boyd Figge of Lancaster, Mo., Raymond Figge of Ottumwa, Ia., Russell Figge of Lancaster, Mo., Charles Figge of Numa, Ia., and Mrs. Luther (Virginia) Riggins of Rock Island, Ill.; four grandchildren; two great grandchildren; one brother, Ples Figge of Queen City and two sisters, Eunice James of Queen City and Orpha Sweikert of La Plata.

Mr. Figge was a life-long resident of Schuyler County where he attended the old Charity Rule School. He was engaged in farming in the Germania neighborhood east of Queen City until 1958 when he retired and moved to Queen City.

He attended the Germania Methodist Church.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon, November 25, 1970 at 2:00 p.m. in the Dooley Funeral Chapel in Queen City with the Rev. Kenneth Campbell of Memphis, Mo., officiating. Burial was in the Germania Cemetery.
