

Minnie T. Johnson In Died At Kirksville

Minnie Turessa Johnson, youngest child of Mr. and Mrs. George Johnson, was born near Queen City, Ga., June 7, 1918, and passed away at a Kirksville hospital Thursday, March 21, 1929, aged 10 years, 9 months, and 12 days. She underwent an operation for appendicitis, but lived only two days after the operation.
