

Obituary.

Mrs. Margarette (Farris) Miller was born in Indiana, April 27, 1827. At the age of about seventeen she came to Randolph county, Mo., and later to Schuyler county where she spent the most of the remainder of her life. In early life she united with the Methodist Episcopal church and in 1849 she united in marriage with Christian Miller. March 11, 1877 she united with the St. John's Evangelical Lutheran church of Germania of which she continued a member till her death. She was the mother of twelve children, five sons and seven daughters. Three sons and three daughters with a large concourse of friends remain to mourn her departure. She fell asleep in Jesus in the home of her daughter, Mrs. Susan Barnes, in Trenton, Mo., about noon, April 13, 1908, aged eighty years, eleven months and sixteen days. The remains reached Queen City on Wednesday evening, and by the personal kindness of Mr. and Mrs. Nicholas Sloop, were taken to their home, whence on Thursday morning, after a brief service, the funeral cortege proceeded to the St. John's Lutheran church where Rev. Dr. Jacoby the pastor conducted the funeral service at 11 o'clock. Following this service the interment was made in the Germania Lutheran cemetery.
