

Obituary.

W. F. Miller was born in Hannibal, Mo., March, 15, 1848, and died at his home in Schuyler Co., Mo., Nov. 17, 1911, being 63 years, 8 months and 2 days of age.

On Dec. 3, 1861 he was married to Miss Martha E. Miller. To this union 8 children were born, of whom two are now living: Henry R. and William Franklin.

On Nov. 20, 1888, our brother was bereft of his companion.

Brother Miller was again married Nov. 15, 1893, to Sophia Egbert. To them one child, Mable Louise, was born. Again the shadow of death entered Bro. Miller's home Nov. 15, 1903, taking the wife and mother of the home.

For many years the departed had been a member of the Methodist Episcopal church at Germania. He was a faithful, earnest christian and lived to help many to a happier and more perfect christian life. He has been for more than 20 years an official of the church and has had its interest on his heart.

To mourn his departure, besides his two sons and daughter, he leaves one brother, John H. Miller, one half brother and four half sisters and his many friends.

The funeral services were conducted by Rev. C. C. Crickette, assisted by Rev. C. J. Fester at the St. John's Lutheran church and the body laid to rest in the Germania cemetery, Sunday Nov. 19, 1911.
