

CLARENCE FRANKLIN PERRY

Clarence F. Perry, life-long resident of this community died at his home several miles N. E. of Queen City shortly after noon on Sunday, February 19th, at the age of 79 years, 11 months, and two days.

Clarence was the son of George W. and Elizabeth (Cooper) Perry and was born near Queen City on March 17, 1876.

On May 1, 1901 he was united in marriage to Cuba Belle Figge. They had one daughter, Helen. They spent their 53 years of married life, prior to her tragic death on June 11, 1954. on the same farm where he died.

He was received into the membership of St. John's Lutheran church by adult baptism and confession of faith on December 28, 1955. He was a good husband, father and neighbor.

He is survived by his daughter, Mrs. Helen Patton of Queen City; two sisters, Mrs. Clara Mull of Hillsboro, Oregon, who is a twin sister; and Mrs. Lydia Johnson of Queen City; six brothers, Edgar, Jess, and Willis of Queen City, John and Jake of Kansas and Wilbur of California; two grandchildren Harold Brumbaugh of Queen City and Mrs. Irene Goosey of Springfield, Ill; and three great grandchildren also a host of relatives and friends. His wife and three brothers Alva, Commodore and Robert preceded him in death.

Funeral services were held at St. John's Lutheran church, Wednesday, February 22, at 2:00 p.m. The body was laid to rest in Germania Fabius cemetery. Rev. A. O. Althafer officiated at these services.
