

MRS. ELIZABETH PERRY  
1848-1934

Elizabeth Cooper, daughter of Charles and Betsy Cooper, was born in Fairmont, Clark county, Mo., May 16, 1848. When about sixteen years old she married a Mr. Childers. To them one son, Wm., was born. Mr. Childers having died, she married G. W. Perry, August 11, 1866.

To them were born ten sons and two daughters, viz: Warren Edgar and Jesse Allen of Queen City; John Albert, Davenport, Iowa; Clarence Franklin, Queen City; Clara Frances, Lewistown, Montana; Alva, Bloomfield, Iowa; Jacob, Kansas; Commodore, deceased; Lydia May, Charles Robert and George Willis, Queen City and Clyde Wilbert, California.

Her husband, G. W. Perry, preceded her in death. In early life she united with the Lutheran church and continued in good standing till her departure.
