

Mrs. Jesse Perry Dies At Home Thursday

Mrs. Elizabeth Susan Perry, wife of Jesse Perry, who survives, died at the family home yesterday about 10:30 a. m. She was born January 13, 1870, and was married February 28, 1897, no children being born in the family. She was a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. N. E. Crawford, of Tennessee. The immediate cause of her death was given as acute peritonitis. She was a member of the Lutheran church.

Four brothers survive: George Crawford, of Marshalltown, Ia., John L. Crawford, of Joliet, Ill., Jacob N. Crawford and James Crawford, both of Green County Tenn. The surviving sisters are Mrs. Maggie Williams, Mrs. Lillie J. Perry and Miss Dollie Crawford.

Mrs. Perry was sick only a short time and her death was quite a shock to the entire community. The funeral services were held at the St. John's Lutheran church at 2 o'clock today and were in charge of Rev. J. F. Hershiser. The interment was at the Germania cemetery. Short funeral services were held at the home at 11:30 this morning.
