

JESSE ALLEN PERRY

Jesse Allen, son of George W. and Elizabeth (Cooper) Perry was born April 7, 1869 several miles N. E. of Queen City. He passed away at the Greentop Nursing Home Tuesday, February 28, 1956 at the age of 86 years, 10 months and 21 days. He was a life long resident of this community.

He was united in marriage to Elizabeth Susa Crawford. They settled on a farm near the St. John's Lutheran church. Because of his wife's poor health they moved to Queen City in 1910. She passed away April 5, 1917. Jesse lived in Queen City until last fall when he entered the nursing home.

Jesse, Edgar and their father all united with St. John's Lutheran Church, November 19, 1887. He transferred his membership to St. Mark's Lutheran church November 21, 1915.

He leaves to mourn his death two sisters, Mrs. Lydia Johnson of Queen City, Mrs. Clara Mull of Hillsboro, Ore., five brothers, Edgar, and Willis of Queen City, John and Jake of Kansas and Wilbert of California, and many relatives and friends. His wife and four brothers preceded him in death, Alva, Commodore, Robert and Clarence who passed away on February 19th.

Funeral services were held at the St. John's Lutheran church, Wednesday, February 29, 1956 at two p. m. The body was laid to rest at Germania Cemetery. Rev. A. O. Althafer officiated at these services.
