

**FINAL RITES FOR

Frank Daniel Schaefer, son of Daniel and Gertrude (Voor) Schaefer was born in Schuyler County, Missouri on February 11, 1885 and passed away Friday evening on December 15, 1967 at Bloomfield, Ia. He was 82 years, ten months and four days old.

Mr. Schaefer was married to Nellie Bolston, June 12, 1910. To this union three children were born, Paul, Ag; ss and Garnett. Mrs. Schaefer passed away in November 1943. He was also preceded in death by two sisters, Mrs. Anna Marie Betward and Mrs. Nellie Barnett.
