

FINAL RITES FOR FRANK DANIEL SCHAFER

Frank Daniel Schaffer, son of Daniel and Gertrude (D'aur) Schaffer was born in Schuyler County, Missouri on February 11, 1885 and passed away Friday evening on December 15, 1967 at Bloomfield, Ia. He was 82 years, ten months and four days old.

Mr. Schaffer was married to Nellie Rolston, June 12, 1910. To this union three children were born, Paul, Agnes and Garnett. Mrs. Schaffer passed away in November 1943. He was also preceded in death by two sisters, Mrs. Anna Marie Bonward and Mrs. Nellie Barnett.
