

**FINAL RITES HELD SUNDAY
FOR MRS FRANK SCHAFER**

Nellie Rolston, the daughter of George W. and Louisa Spears Rolston was born September 23, 1881, and died November 26, 1943 at her home six miles south-east of Lancaster, at the age of 62 years, two months, and three days.

On June 12, 1910 she was married to Frank D. Schafer who survives her. Also surviving are one son, Paul, of Glenwood; two daughters, Agnes and Garnet, at home; one sister, Mrs. Alice Wayman and one brother, William Rolston, both of Blackwell, Oklahoma.

Before her marriage, Mrs. Schafer attended the Kirksville Normal School and taught in the rural schools of this county for eight years. She was interested in the welfare of the community in which she lived, and was an active member of W. P. F. A.

When quite young, she became a member of the Christian Church, and after her marriage had her membership transferred to the St. John's Lutheran. She has long been a member of the St. John's ladies aid. At one time she was active in the Greentop Order of the Eastern Star, and also the Rebekah's.

But the main interest of Nellie Schafer was in her home and her family. No work was too tiring no task too great if by performing it she would make easier the way of any member of her family.

The body laid in state at the Fenton Funeral Home until time of the funeral services. The funeral was conducted at the St. John's Lutheran Church by Rev. Eshbaugh. Burial at the Germania cemetery.
