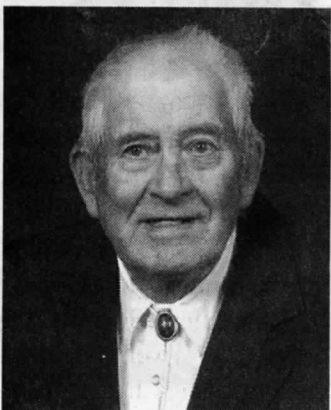


# *Donald Edwin Schubert*

Donald Edwin Schubert, 78, of rural Queen City MO passed away at the Scotland County Care Center in Memphis MO on Saturday, September 29, 2007.
