

Obituary.

Mrs Rosa Anna Schafer, daughter of Leonard and Mary Schafer, peacefully fell asleep Saturday, May 30th, 1914 in the hospital at Bloomfield, after an illness of many years, at the age of 41 years, 1 month and 29 days. Having been baptised in infancy, she united with St. John's Lutheran Church in the holy act of Confirmation and was a life long and consistent member of the church.
