

JOHN SCHUPBACH

John Schupbach, son of Christopher and Mary Schupbach, was born on a farm five miles southwest of Downing, Missouri, the 12th day of October, 1869. Departed this life February 24th, 1945, being 75 years, 4 months and 12 days of age.

He was baptized into the Lutheran faith October 13, 1887.

He was united in marriage to Meta Sena Ehler, October 15, 1895. To this union four children were born: Herman Robert, Elmer Henry and Mrs. Hilda Anna Kearse, who survive. Wilbur Franklin, preceded him in death on Sept. 1, 1926. His companion also passed away the 5th of March 1939.

The deceased was one of a family of nine children of whom Mrs. Louisa Nicholson, Miss Theresia Schupbach, of Downing, and William of Kirksville, survive.
