Marguerite Slade, 62, of Miami, Florida, formerly of rural Queen City, died Tuesday afternoon, April 19, 1977 in a hospital in Miami, Florida. She had been ill only a short time.

The daughter of William and Ethel Figge McElroy, she was born in the Germania community east of Queen City on October 3, 1914. In 1944 she was married to Jules R. Slade and to this marriage two children were born.

Surviving are one son, Rick Slade, Miami, Florida; one daughter, Mrs. Charles (Kaydene) Zechman, Hollywood, Florida; one brother, Virgil McElroy of Falls Church, Va., and two granddaughters, Tiffany and Julie Zechman.

She was preceded in death by her mother in December 1923; her father in November 1961; one infant sister and one brother, Lawrence McElroy in 1967.

Following the death of her mother, Mrs. Slade moved with her family to the state of Kansas. She resided in Washington, D.C., before moving to the state of Florida.

She had been employed as a beautician and clerical typist before her retirement. She was also active in volunteer work for the Heart Association.

Mrs. Slade was a member of the First Christian Church of Miami, Florida.

Graveside services were held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock in the Germania Cemetery east of Queen City. The Rev. Bill Christman, pastor of the Queen City Christian Church, conducted the services, which were under the direction of the Dooley Funeral Home of Queen City.
