

Obituary.

Fredrick Smith was born in Herron Causen Hessen Darmstadt, Germany, Dec. 24, 1832 and died Jan. 9, 1913, aged 80 years and 16 days. He was baptized in infancy and brought up in the Lutheran faith.

In 1844 he emigrated to America with his parents and located in Schuyler Co., Missouri, where he lived until the time of his death.

On April 5, 1854 he was married to Wehlmima Knittel. To this union were born two sons, who died in infancy, and two daughters, Mrs. Hiram Yates and Katherine Smith, who survive their father. On Sept. 9, 1862 his wife died.

He was again united in marriage on May 11, 1871, to Henrietta Knittel who passed from this life Dec. 21, 1911. Four sons and one daughter were born to this union. One son, William, died Nov. 19, 1901. The other children are Mrs. Jerry Yates, Henry J., Frank and Victor, who, with a brother, Henry Smith of Queen City, six grand children, two great grand children and many other relatives and friends mourn his death.

The funeral services were conducted by Rev. Crickette at the St. John's Lutheran church and the body laid to rest in the Germania cemetery, Sunday, Jan. 12, 1913.
