

MRS LIZZIE ANNA SMITH DIES AT KEOKUK HOSPITAL

Mrs. Lizzie Anna Smith of Warsaw died in St. Joseph's Hospital, Keokuk, Sunday afternoon, July 18, 1943 at 12:25 o'clock.

Mrs. Smith was born in Ederbringhausen, Germany, on October 4, 1871. She was the daughter of Johannes and Elizabeth Maurer.

She came to this country in 1897 and on February 7, 1905 was married to William H. Smith who survives her. She is also survived by a daughter, Mrs. Fred Haage and a granddaughter, Doris Emma Haage, of Warsaw, and by two brothers in Germany. A son died in infancy.

Short funeral services were held from the Jingt Funeral Home at 9:00 o'clock Tuesday morning. The regular services were held that afternoon from the Lutheran church of Queen City, Mo., of which Mrs. Smith was a member. Burial was in the Germania cemetery.
