

**FINAL RITES FOR
MARTHA SNOWBARGER**

Martha Catherine Snowbarger, daughter of T. G. and Hannah Elizabeth Neeley, was born March 19th 1871 near Lancaster, Mo. and departed this life Nov. 7th 1946 at the Grim-Smith Hospital in Kirksville being 75 years, 7 months and 18 days old.

She was united in marriage to Samuel H. Snowbarger Feb. 25th 1894 and to this union were born the following children: Mrs. Clara Schubert, Nellie, Sherman, Grace and Ruth Snowbarger. She also has two step-daughters: Mrs. William Schmitter and Mrs. John Schmitter.
