

Funeral at Lancaster for Miss Eliza Weitzel

Lancaster, May 23. (Special)—Miss Eliza Weitzel, 77, died suddenly Monday morning about 5 o'clock at the home of her sister, Mrs. Joseph Barnes, who lives on a farm about six miles southeast of Lancaster. Funeral services were to be held this afternoon at two o'clock in the Methodist Church at Germania, conducted by the Rev. H. E. Keltner, pastor. Burial was to be in the Germania Cemetery, several miles away.

Miss Weitzel apparently was in her usual health at the time of her death, having just finished a hearty breakfast and had taken a few steps from the table when she collapsed. Death is believed to have been due to a heart attack.

She was born on a farm in the Germania neighborhood in Schuyler County, May 13, 1857, the daughter of Christian and Wilhelmina Weitzel, who came here from Germany. She has resided in practically the same neighborhood all her life. She is survived by three sisters and a brother, Mrs. Joseph Barnes, Mrs. Charles Craig, Mrs. Henry Craig and Fred Weitzel, all living on farms near Lancaster.
