

MRS. FRED WEITZEL

Sarah Charlotte, daughter of J. J. and Cynthia Slightom, was born December 1, 1873, in Schuyler County, Missouri, near where she spent her entire life, 6 miles Northeast of Queen City.

She was united in marriage with Fred Weitzel, December 4, 1890. To this union two daughters were born, Phoebe Florence, who died in infancy, and Mrs. Carrie Brenizer, of Novelty, Missouri, who with the father survive. She is also survived by three grand children and one great grand child. The grand children, Freddie Brenizer of La Grange, Mo., and Victor and Perley of Novelty. The great grand child Robert Frederick Brenizer of La Grange. Two brothers, Albert Slightom of Downing, Mo., and W. H. Slightom, of Lodi, California, several nieces and nephews.

With the exception of nearly two years spent in Queen City, they have spent their entire married life in the community of their present home, had lived forty-one years in the house where she died May 24, 1941, at the age of 67 years, 5 months and 24 days.

In her early girlhood she united with the Charity Baptist church, later transferred her membership to be with her husband in the St. John's Lutheran church, where she had been a faithful and active member as long as health permitted. She had been in feeble health for the last eighteen years, seriously ill for the last four weeks, suffering greatly, but patiently enduring her pain.

Funeral services were held in the afternoon Tuesday, May 27, in the St. John's church conducted by Perley M. Lind, pastor of the Queen City Christian church. The body laid to rest in the Germania cemetery.
